Dear Ms. Benjamin:

Your request for all emails from Nora Dukowitz to the City Council for the period of July 13, 2014 through July 17, 2014 is partially denied for the following reason:

- The request asks for preliminary drafts, notes, recommendations, memoranda and other records in which opinions are expressed, or policies or actions are formulated, except that a specific record or relevant portion of a record shall not be exempt when the record is publicly cited and identified by the head of the public body which is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(f) of 5 ILCS 140/7.
- The request asks for “private information”, which, if disclosed, would provide information including a person’s social security number, home or personal telephone number, home address, and other unique identifiers, which is exempt from disclosure under Section 7(1)(b) of 5 ILCS 140/7.

You have the right to have this decision reviewed by the Public Access Counselor, Sarah Pratt. You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
