The detention basin (dry basin) on the West side of Savanna Street in the Fox Hollow Subdivision has had standing water for several years. The City's Chapter 24 ordinances were not enforced resulting in the existing condition. The drainage pipe is clogged and broken. Due to the wet conditions, vegetation can not be controlled. It is a perfect breeding ground for mosquitos and vermin such as muskrats that are now nesting in the banks. The putrid stench from the stagnant water and rotting vegetation is also bothersome to the homeowners of adjacent properties. The City accepted the property for maintenance and is aware of the issue but claims insufficient funds to rectify the problem. It would be greatly appreciated if the parcel of land could be inspected by your office and the report filed with the City. Thank you.
