Dear Mr. Jones:

Our firm represents the Bloomington-Normal Airport Authority (BNAA), which has responsibility for the Central Illinois Regional Airport (CIRA). Please accept this as CIRA's response to the above Request for Review pursuant to 5 ILCS 120/3.5. CIRA takes the Request very seriously, and wishes to address each issue as fully as possible. Should you require additional information, please do not hesitate to contact the undersigned.

• 1) Is CIRA's website maintained by full-time Airport staff?

CIRA confirms it has a website, located at www.cira.com. While it does not have full-time information technology staff, the Airport Authority has a small number of staff members who share this responsibility to do their best to keep the site updated. However, there are technical limitations that CIRA is currently addressing and is more than willing to explain its latest efforts.

While the website has basic information related to airport operations, our client advises the website is currently running off of a computer with an outdated operating system. Further, the software used to update the website is sixteen (16) years old and has not been supported for quite some time.

These concerns have been brought to the attention of the BNAA Board, which is committed to working with staff to prepare the necessary Request for Proposal (RFP) for developing a new website and any related hosting needs. This concern can be

traced back to at least June 2015, when initial considerations for an RFP for the website began. See Regular Meeting Minutes of BNAA Board of Commissioners, June 11, 2015, p. 5 (under "B. Deputy Director of Marketing"), attached as Exhibit A. Building upon these initial discussions, staff has prepared an RFP and the Board recently voted to tentatively approve \$50,000.00 in the coming year's capital budget (eff. May 1, 2016) to fund the development and introduction of a new website. See proposed capital budget, attached as Exhibit B. The vote on the budget ordinance will occur during the May Board meeting in accordance with the Illinois Airport Authorities Act.

Our client has already undertaken serious research and learned of the countless possibilities for a website, and it has done so with a careful eye toward being responsible stewards of taxpayer dollars on a final decision.

The present plan is for CIRA to develop a "Governmental" or "Transparency" portal on a new website by the end of 2016, depending on the amount of interest generated by the RFP. Our client is committed to having this portal comply with the Open Meetings Act and the Freedom of Information Act, including, and most important to this Request for Review, posting meeting notices, agendas, and minutes, and any other documents required by these laws. This is especially true in light of the unique and ever-increasing security features for an airport (as more fully explained below).

2) Has CIRA posted a schedule of its regular meetings for the year?

While our client is committed to upgrading its online presence, it also takes this opportunity to explain its existing efforts to comply with the Open Meetings Act.

CIRA already publically posts its notices and/or agendas for its monthly board meetings and any committee meetings. All such notices, agendas, and its annual schedule of meetings are posted on the airport grounds at the BNAA office. While it is uncommon to have a large crowd for the meetings, our client confirms that a representative from the League of Women Voters attends regularly, as do various tenants of the airport because of the notices and agendas posted.

CIRA also faxes or emails the notices/agendas at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance to anyone who has requested them, including those who have made requests in the past but fail to do so on an annual basis. Examples of such facsimile transaction reports for 2015 and 2016 are included with this response as Group Exhibit C.

Further still, CIRA provides minutes of these meetings (once approved) to the Town of Normal, City of Bloomington, McLean County, the Bloomington Pantagraph newspaper, and any other entities or individuals who have requested them. CIRA is certainly willing to provide them to the requester at issue here should she so desire.

Our client is also very aware of its obligation to adopt an annual schedule of meetings and typically approves a schedule for the following year during its October Board meetings. A copy of the annual schedule (and related minutes from the October 2015 Board meeting) is attached hereto as Exhibit D.



All Board notices, agendas, and its annual schedule of meetings are not only provided as outlined above, but are publicly posted at the "principal office" of the BNAA, which is located on the grounds of CIRA within the terminal building, but outside of the security checkpoint. Specifically, these documents are posted on the wall in the center of the office's lobby, which is open daily to the public from 7:00-30am to 6:00pm.

As you can imagine, for numerous security reasons, the office must remain locked when it is closed, and the same is true for the entire terminal building, which is secured from 12:00am to 4:00am daily (a time during which no flights are coming in/out of CIRA). Securing and protecting every square inch of an airport (especially when it is closed) is required by countless Federal Aviation Administration and other regulations, and CIRA regrettably understands these regulations and obligations impact the availability of its various public postings. Indeed, these regulations put the availability of CIRA public postings for 48 continuous hours "outside of [CIRA's] control" under 5 ILCS 120/2.02(c), but please understand that providing a safe airport is a responsibility CIRA takes very seriously.

Despite the above, CIRA is doing its best to make all postings available to the public for as long as possible before any meeting occurs. At no time has it ever done anything willfully or intentionally to avoid its obligations under the law. It remains committed to balancing transparency with the safety of the public. If you have recommendations on how to better make these postings available, CIRA is certainly willing to work with your office on doing so.

CIRA hopes this Response addresses all of your office's concerns, but is very willing to address any further comments and questions. It remains committed to being as transparent as possible, and is excited at the possibility of providing greater access to the public once its new website has been completed.

BLOOMINGTON – NORMAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS REGULAR MEETING MINUTES THURSDAY, JUNE 11, 2015 4:30 PM

I. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chairman Allen called the meeting to order at 4:32 p.m. Commissioners Kannaday, Whisman, and Sender were present. Commissioners Hanson, Bock and Chairman Colee were absent. A quorum was acknowledged.

II. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Steve Schmidt was present to update the Board on the Museum. This Sunday, June 14th is Fun Day at the Airport with plenty of activities and exhibits. The blue trailer will also be moved as soon as the ground firms up and the trailer can be towed out. The first open cockpit day is scheduled for next Saturday, June 20th.

III. APPROVAL OF MAY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

Commissioner Sender made a motion to approve the May meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

IV. OLD BUSINESS

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. <u>Audit/Finance Committee</u> No reason to meet, no report
- B. <u>General Aviation Committee</u> The GA Committee met on June 4 to discuss the proposal from Dumont Aviation. That item will be covered later on the agenda.
- C. <u>Personnel Committee</u> No reason to meet, no report.
- D <u>Public Policy Committee</u> No reason to meet, no report.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. Approve Consent to Assign Image Jet Center, LLC Ground Lease – In the spring of 2012 Heartland Bank approached the Airport Authority with a request to assign the ground lease

associated with the former Platinum Aviation hangar to a perspective new building owner, Image Jet Center, LLC. As a part of approving this assignment the Board also allowed the term to be extended through 2047.

At this time the owners of Image Jet Center, LLC have now approached the Airport Authority with a request to assign the ground lease to Dumont Group Properties III LLC as a part of their selling the facility to Dumont. The existing terms/conditions would remain the same as currently presented. It was noted that once the ground lease is assigned to Dumont, they are responsible for the payments on the lease, even if their business plan doesn't work out. As with the other parties in the past, should Dumont wish to leave, they would have the ability to ask for the airport's consent to assign the ground lease to another party.

Commissioner Kannaday made a motion to approve the assignment of the current restated ground lease between the Airport Authority and Image Jet Center LLC to Dumont Group Properties III, LLC and that airport Staff and legal counsel are authorized to refine and execute the required documents as needed to effect the assignment. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

B. Approve Award of Commercial Aviation Operating Privileges to Dumont Aviation – In late 2014, Staff was contacted by an aviation business brokerage firm that explained they had been retained by the owners of Image Jet Center, LLC facility to identify and coordinate the sale of the building. A prospective buyer, Dumont Aviation, made a site visit on February 4, 2015. This was Staff's opportunity to introduce the general practices of operating a commercial aviation service at CIRA along with the Airport Authority's requirements and what types of schedules would have to be considered. Since the visit on February 4th, Dumont Aviation has submitted their minimum standards application to provide commercial aviation operating privileges at CIRA.

After a review of their application and business plan and a meeting with the GA Committee it was determined that Dumont met the minimum standards for providing commercial aviation operating privileges. Dumont currently holds an FAA issued Part 145 Repair Station License and a Part 135 Air Taxi/Charter Certificate for their operation in Wilmington Delaware.

Kevin Wargo and Dan Piraino from Dumont were present at the Board meeting to talk further about their plans for CIRA and to answer any questions the Board may have. Mr. Wargo explained that by coming to CIRA it would allow Dumont to expand their maintenance business and allow them to support the Chicago, Indianapolis and the middle of the US region with their charter fleet. Dumont is also working to reenter the 30 seat on demand charter market with regional aircraft. Those aircraft will be based at CIRA and primarily they will principally serve NCAA team charters as well as larger corporate customers. Their company has grown from 3 employees, just over three years ago to more than 85 currently. They anticipate hiring 10 to 12 new positions at CIRA in the first 6 months and they have plans to create just about as big of a facility/operation as they have in Delaware. They also reported they will begin working with the FAA to establish a standalone Part 145 Repair Station License for their location at CIRA.

During their presentation, both Mr. Wargo and Mr. Piraino commented their business plan calls for Dumont to introduce new business to CIRA by expanding the services beyond which is currently being attracted.

Commissioner Sender inquired if there was any concerns with the ramp parking that was described in Dumont's business plan. Carl explained that conversations have been had with Dumont that sufficient area is available for them to use, but there will be no preferential or exclusive use arrangement for Dumont. Carl explained the entire apron area is common use and open to all aircraft operators. Carl also explained that Dumont had been advised, and concurred, with how the Airport Authority manages/coordinates this area.

It was explained at this time that Dumont does not meet the minimum standards for commercial fueling. They are free to come back to the Board for approval once they have met the minimum standards. They are however, free to do their own fueling in their own aircraft. The FAA requires airports to allow aircraft owners to self fuel their own airplane with their own fuel and their own staff.

Commissioner Kannaday inquired if Dumont would be discontinuing any services in Delaware with the opening of the Bloomington location. Kevin Wargo responded their CIRA presence would be in addition to their ongoing activities in Wilmington. Commissioner Kannaday also inquired about Dumont's future plans and if they envision opening other sites. Mr. Wargo advised that Dumont was also looking to expand into other markets as well, including the southern and western portions of the U.S.

Commissioner Allen reported that the GA Committee did have a very long discussion with Dumont on June 4th. The Committee was very pleased with their detailed business plan and at the conclusion of the meeting, recommended that the plan be brought to the full board. The type of market sectors that Dumont is interested in and heavily involved in, is really not the same general aviation market sector that the current 2 operators are as involved in. This is a diversification of general aviation services at CIRA.

Commissioner Sender made a motion to approve the awarding of commercial aviation operating privileges to Dumont Group Properties III LLC to provide; aircraft sales, aircraft maintenance, aircraft management, aircraft charter services, hangar service, and aircraft parts and avionics sales/service in accordance with their minimum standards application. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kannaday and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

C. <u>Approval of May Financial Statements</u> — Commissioner Sender noted that the investment report and the bond summary were very helpful. He also inquired about the 2 delinquent accounts. Carl noted that there is considerable progress being made on the first account and that Staff will have to consult legal counsel on how to proceed with the 2nd account.

Commissioner Sender made a motion to approve the May Financial Statements. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote the motion carried.

D. Adopt Ordinance No. 177-15, The Annual Tax Levy for CY2015 – Pursuant to the Illinois Airport Authorities Act, the airport is to adopt their annual tax levy on or before the 2nd Tuesday in August. This tax levy will generate tax revenue in calendar year 2016 that will be programmed into the FY2017 budget. For the 52nd year, there is no increase in the corporate tax rate. It remains at 4 cents per \$100 of assessed value. A public hearing was not needed as the levy didn't increase more than 5%. Commissioner Whisman made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 177-15 the annual tax levy for CY2015. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Kannaday and upon a roll call vote; Commissioner Kannaday, - aye, Commissioner Hanson -

absent, Commissioner Whisman - aye, Commissioner Bock - absent, Commissioner Sender, aye, Commissioner Colee - absent, Vice-Chairman Allen - aye, the motion carried.

- E. Adopt Ordinance No. 178-15, The Prevailing Wage Rate for FY2016 Commissioner Sender made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 178-15, the Prevailing Wage Rate for FY2016. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote the motion carried.
- F. Approve Amendment to Professional Services Agreement with Crawford, Murphy, and Tilly, Inc. In 2011 the Airport Authority approved a professional services agreement with Crawford, Murphy & Tilly Inc., the airport's engineering firm, for just under \$65,000.00 to do the design/bid services for the passenger boarding bridges. In the process of completing this work CMT was asked to take on some additional tasks, related to relocating and redesigning some airline communication and data lines at the gate counters; modifying the building's electrical system to accommodate the specific utility draws of the boarding bridges and to change door hardware/access control system to match the package with what is currently being used in the building. As a result of this additional work, CMT incurred an additional cost of \$20,400. As such, CMT has requested an amendment to their contract to reimburse them for these additional expenses. The IDA and the FAA have previously approved this change which will be 90% reimbursable from the FAA.

Commissioner Kannaday made a motion to authorize the execution of a contract amendment to CMT as presented for the additional cost of \$20,400. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote the motion carried.

VII. STAFF REPORTS

A. <u>Executive Director's Report</u> - Carl reported that about 2 weeks ago, CIRA was proud to host Congressman Rodney Davis on his aviation listening tour. It was very well attended with representation from general aviation, corporate aviation, insurance, agriculture, the airport and even education. The topics were FAA reauthorization and UAS (unmanned aerial systems), as their use pertains to insurance companies as well as in agriculture.

Earlier in the week, Carl traveled to Washington DC and had the opportunity to meet with the staff of the 18th Congressional district. He also had a chance to meet with Congressman Kinzinger's staff and Congressman Davis's staff, as well as the Congressman. Several topics were covered, including but not limited to FAA Reauthorization and continued FAA funding for the contract tower program.

CIRA also hosted senior officials from the FAA's Chicago ADO office earlier in the week, along with top officials from IDA. It was a positive meeting with a tour of the airport.

A solution has been identified for the software issue with the new CBIS project. All parties are reviewing the solution to make sure that it doesn't cause any further problems down the line. At this point in time, there isn't a time set for when the solution can be implemented.

B. <u>Deputy Director of Marketing</u> – Fran Strebing was present to update the board on marketing efforts and industry news. May traffic was a little light due to the fact that summer travel hasn't begun yet. Allegiant's still had good results for both routes. American and Delta are doing well. The Detroit market is a little weak but Delta is still pleased with the route and things are looking good. The upgrading of Delta aircraft/seats remains very fluid with some measured increase in capacity for the peak summer months expected. Overall, seat capacity is down May over May due to the loss of Frontier and the Minneapolis flight only being 5 days a week instead of 7.

Fran and Carl went to the Allegiant conference in April and one of the specific messages from the CEO was that "cost control at your airport will directly affect service from Allegiant." So the ability for CIRA to maintain costs is very important. Allegiant is growing in all kinds of markets from small to big. Conversations are ongoing with the incumbent airlines and Staff continues to look for new opportunities.

The marketing message has been summer vacations. Still using local radio and in other markets. That message will soon shift to planning fall trips and will be geared toward those markets that are losing Orlando service for the fall.

The RFP for the website has begun. The goal is to have it on the street by July 15th and a target date of December 1 for a new updated website.

Working off the McLean County Disaster Council group a Public Information Officer group has started. That group met earlier this month to do a table top exercise. The group is modeled after a group that actually was formed over in Peoria that handled the Washington Tornado disaster.

Mr. Steve Schmidt was present from the Prairie Aviation Museum to update the board. The Museum had a fantastic September, with the highest number of guests ever in September. The open cockpit day on the 19th was the best attended open cockpit day the Museum has ever had. It was a great way to end the summer season at the Museum. Over the past weekend, there was a 4-H event utilizing the old terminal with tours for about 50 kids. Looking forward to a more quiet fall.

III. APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

A. <u>September Board Meeting Minutes</u> - Commissioner Allen made a motion to approve the September meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hanson and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

V. COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. <u>Audit/Finance Committee</u> No reason to meet, no report.
- B. General Aviation Committee The G.A. Committee met on September 24th with representatives from Synergy who presented their expansion plans. Part of the expansion includes Synergy purchasing the existing hangars from the Airport. Those details are being worked out.
- C. <u>Personnel Committee</u> No reason to meet, no report.
- **D** Public Policy Committee No reason to meet, no report.

VI. NEW BUSINESS

A. Approval of September Financials Statements – Diane Andes Finney reported to the Board on the financials. There were not a lot of extra ordinary events in the month of September, nor many changes. The airport has received all but a little bit of the tax revenue distribution, which sets up the general fund for the coming winter months. The cash balance in the general fund is about \$1.8 million. Revenue was about 5% ahead of budget for the month. Expenses were below budget, except for utilities and seasonal equipment that was purchased to get ready for winter. The hangar fund revenue is right on budget for the month. The capital fund saw a slight decrease in the cash balance due to the fact that no grant funds have been received. Staff is still waiting on TSA reimbursement for the baggage screening project.

Commissioner Whisman made a motion to approve the September Financial statements. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hanson and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

B. Adopt Resolution No. 2015-2, Authorizing Renewal of Line of Credit with Commerce Bank During the October 2014 regular meeting the Board of Commissioners adopted a resolution authorizing the one year renewal of a \$1.0 million dollar line of credit with Commerce Bank. The principal purpose for having this line of credit available is to support the Airport Authority's capital improvement program and project cash flows while federal and state reimbursements are processed. The line of credit has been in place since January '07 when it was originated with Bank of Illinois and used to support the remodel of CJs Restaurant. Since that time the line of credit has never been used.

In line with both the current banking services agreement and the expiring facility with Commerce Bank, the interest rate for the coming year will be a floating rate equal to the 30 day LIBOR plus 225 basis points with no minimum interest floor. Additionally, the Airport Authority will not be assessed any fees for not using this line of credit.

Commissioner Allen made a motion to adopt Resolution 2015-2, authorizing the renewal of a line of credit with Commerce Bank. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote the motion carried.

Adopt Ordinances No.s 179-15, 180-15 and 181-15, Ordinances Conditionally and Partially Abating Property Tax for Sites in the City of Bloomington - Carl introduced Mr. David Hales, City Manager for the City Bloomington, and Mr. Austin Grammer, Economic Development Coordinator for the City of Bloomington. Mr. Grammer explained the 3 projects that are seeking property tax abatements. The 3 sites are 312/314 N. Main (Mid-City Properties), 407/409 W. Washington St. (Haney Plumbing and Rental) and 915/921 E. Washington St. (The Foundry Retail Development). The abatements would be the new incremental revenue that would be generated by the redevelopment of each property. The abatement would be for the first 5 years. Without the tax abatements, the projects wouldn't happen. The airport has done this previously with 115 E. Monroe.

The property at 312/314 N. Main is Beck's flower shop. Mid City Properties would like to develop the upper floors into 6 loft apartments. The minimum investment requirement by the developer for the project is \$847,000, with a 5 year property tax abatement with an annual 3% increase each year.

The property at 407/409 W. Washington is owned by Joe and Ruth Haney of Haney Plumbing and Rental. The building was originally a farm implement dealership and most recently was the Salvation Army Thrift Store. The Haney's purchased the building at auction and turned it into apartments. The Bloomington City Council approved a tax abatement for the project back in January of 2014, however, due to staffing changes at the City, the project was not taken to all the other taxing bodies to be approved. The Haney's went ahead and started and completed the project. The investment in the project to date is \$1.2 million dollars.

The property at 915/921 E. Washington St. is the Foundry Retail Development. This site is formerly the site of American Foundry and Furnace, a manufacturing facility next to Beer Nuts. The facility is no longer there and the site is just a grassy lot. The proposal is to construction two 10,000 square foot retail buildings, with one of those buildings being the home to Green Top Grocery, which is a new grocery co-op start up in Bloomington. The other building would be rented out to other tenants and they all would be paying their pro- rated share of the property tax, through a triple net lease. If those places are not rented, then the tax abatement would be benefiting the developer of the property. This would be a new development that is not on Veteran's Parkway and the area is in a USDA food desert. By bringing a grocery store to the location, it will be bringing groceries to an area that doesn't have anything. The location is also on Constitution Trail as well as being on 2 bus routes. The minimum investment in the project is \$2.4 million dollars. The total amount of the property taxes to be abated over the 5 years is \$150,000. The City of Bloomington is also supporting the development with a sales tax rebate for Green Top Grocery up to \$390,000 over 10 years. This will assist with the initial build out cost.

The Airport Authority would experience a projected revenue reduction of approximately \$908 per year, or a projected total waiver of \$4,540 for this entire 5 year period. If the projects didn't happen, then there would be no need for the abatement, nor would there be an increase in the taxes at the end of 5 years. Commissioner Hanson made a motion to adopt Ordinances 179-15, 180-15 and 181-15, conditionally and partially abating property tax for sites in the City of Bloomington. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Allen and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

D. Approval of CY2016 Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting Schedule - It has been brought to the Board's attention that the schedule for 2016 conflicts with a member's calendar and that member wouldn't be able to attend the meetings. After receiving feedback from all members, Commissioner Allen made a motion to move the meetings for 2016 to the second Tuesday of each month at 4:30 p.m. The schedule will resume to the 2nd Thursday of every month starting in 2017. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Whisman and upon a unanimous vote, the motion carried.

VII. STAFF REPORTS

A. Executive Director's Report - Carl reported that against a 7% reduction in capacity, CIRA experienced a 4.8% decrease in enplanements for the month of September. Year over year, passengers remain down at the same rate as last month, which was 5.5%. Overall, CIRA experienced stronger results than what is typically seen in the month of September. The Orlando

loads were especially strong. This could be due in part to Allegiant suspending Orlando service in Springfield and Peoria. Dallas and Atlanta continue with strong traffic as well. Minneapolis demonstrated some strength, which was nice to see, despite the less than full schedule. Chicago showed some continued weakness, which seems to be a factor of the late evening departure, making it hard to make any connections in Chicago. Detroit showed weakness as well, which is mostly driven by their schedule. Beginning next month, American is going to start a 4th daily flight to Chicago on a regional jet. That flight will come out in December, but come back into the system in January and February. Delta is going to be increasing the size of the aircraft to Atlanta in January and February. There is no commitment from Delta as to how long that aircraft will stay in the system. Fuel sales increased by almost 5% last month. Aircraft operations continue to show very impressive gains; month over month operations were up about 46% and year to date operations are up 35%. That is a very strong indicator for GA at our facility.

Carl had a conversation with former Commissioner Earl Kingman who recently underwent major back surgery. Mr. Kingman sends his greetings and reports he is doing well and is looking forward to returning home in the next few days.

Carl had the opportunity to join 21 other airports in Galena last week, at the annual Illinois Public Airport Association meeting. There was a full complement of State and FAA officials from Springfield and Washington DC. Aside from the annual Board meeting, some of the topics covered at the conference were UAS's (drones), Federal and State funding options, airport insurance, air service and wildlife updates. Some of the most timely sessions were offered by the FAA, including the Associate Airport Administrator for Planning and Programming, which is the number one airport finance position in the FAA. Illinois Transportation Secretary Blankenhorn was present, along with Steve Young, the Interim Director of Aeronautics for the State.

Chairman Colee inquired how FedEx Express was doing after their first 8 months at CIRA, Carl responded that FedEx has been doing very well while only having positive feedback for staff. Carl also noted the Airport Authority had finalized plans for CIRA's annual pre-winter operational meeting during which the different strategies and operating practices are reviewed with all of the airport's tenants; including FedEx for the first time.

Chairman Colee thanked Carl for his presentation at the BN by the Numbers.

B. <u>Deputy Director of Security and Special Projects</u> — Don Schneider was present to update the Board on all things security and special project related.

The service road project was awarded to Stark Excavation. The state's delay in awarding the contract pushed the start of the project off until spring. Stark did agree to hold the prices that were bid until the project starts.

The fuel farm project is moving forward. Staff met with Crawford, Murphy & Tilly last week to review the design drawings as the project moves toward completion of 100% drawings and completion of bid specifications.

The Tilbury Flash was recently installed here in the terminal building adjacent the security checkpoint area. Mr. Tom Swearingen from the EAA and GROWMARK's flight department participated and supervised the installation from an aircraft perspective. Don also shared that

Tom's connection first started with his Grandfather who helped restore the aircraft the first time and whose name was written inside the aircraft's nose cone.

Don also reported the TSA has started their annual inspection of the Airport Authority's approved security program. Beginning with a page turn of each item in the plan, this inspection is expected to take about a week. Noting the inspection this year is being conducted by two TSA inspectors, Don suggested the completion of this inspection will likely result in a new inspector being assigned to CIRA.

The CBIS project is in the last few days of a 4 week inspection while the TSA is operating the system from the new baggage inspection area. While the results of the testing have been slow coming back to the Airport Authority, there are indications that some continued adjustments will be necessary.

VIII. ADJOURNMENT

There being no other business to come before the Board, upon a motion being made, seconded and approved, the October 8, 2015 meeting of the Bloomington-Normal Airport Authority adjourned at 5:28 p.m.
