First of all, I wanted to extend a congratulations on your season. It was fun to watch you guys from afar throughout the weeks. Your guys improved every week.

This is a bit awkward for me, but I wanted to reach out to ask about compensation for doing film work for you guys throughout the year. Before meeting with the staff, I was told that I would be compensated but never formally sat down to have a conversation with you to discuss terms. I regret this, but I did put in the work with the assumption that I would get compensated in some form once the season concluded. I tried contacting Hudl a week ago to have them pull my amount of time logged in to break down film over the course of the season, but they have yet to get back to me with that information. I didn't want to wait on them any longer, and wanted to reach out to you as quickly as possible.

On average, though, it cost me about 1-1.5 hours per game to completely fill in the columns I was qualified to fill in. Also, I know Hudl charges \$1000 for their Hudl assist program, which essentially does the same work. They do complete a few more additional columns that I did not, however. Plus they guarantee a 24-hour turnaround, which I did not do every week. So my work isn't worth \$1,000, but I do think it warrants \$400-500. Is there a chance we can agree on a specific dollar amount, if at all?

Marty,

When we have district employees who help coach in a high school athletic program, but who are not part of the Schedule B compensation, we sometimes pay them an amount for their work through an activity account. The procedure that we use is to submit the requested payment through Special Payroll, and then the amount is added to their next paycheck. Our bookkeeper sends a check from the sport activity account to the district to deposit into the appropriate payroll account.

Is there a similar procedure that we could use to remit payment to a person who does not work for the school district but where the payment would still come from the district similar to the Special Payroll procedure? We would collect a W-9 form and send a check from the sport activity account to the district to deposit into the appropriate payroll account as we do with district employees.

Please let me know if you think this would be possible. Thanks.







I can easily the NWGIC has not paid any coach directly. There was discussion of this, the year I took over as Treasurer in 2012. But when we opened our own account - I made it clear that would not happen. That avoids taxes, in other words Tax Evasion - which is how a lot of construction workers are paid - but, that is a whole other issue that is battled by the banks and regulators. I make sure any payments to people - go through the Normal West account, such as Dan Higby for operating the scoreboard. I send those checks to Sherri Cheli and they are made out to Normal West. For several years, we did not pay anything for anyone, outside of Dan Higby. But, a couple of years ago, we received the "green light" from a budgeting standpoint to include an expense for assistant coaches as long as it goes through Sherri Cheli - and that is what we do.



First of all, I wanted to extend a congratulations on your season. It was fun to watch you guys from afar throughout the weeks. Your guys improved every week.

This is a bit awkward for me, but I wanted to reach out to ask about compensation for doing film work for you guys throughout the year. Before meeting with the staff, I was told that I would be compensated but never formally sat down to have a conversation with you to discuss terms. I regret this, but I did put in the work with the assumption that I would get compensated in some form once the season concluded. I tried contacting Hudl a week ago to have them pull my amount of time logged in to break down film over the course of the season, but they have yet to get back to me with that information. I didn't want to wait on them any longer, and wanted to reach out to you as quickly as possible.

On average, though, it cost me about 1-1.5 hours per game to completely fill in the columns I was qualified to fill in. Also, I know Hudl charges \$1000 for their Hudl assist program, which essentially does the same work. They do complete a few more additional columns that I did not, however. Plus they guarantee a 24-hour turnaround, which I did not do every week. So my work isn't worth \$1,000, but I do think it warrants \$400-500. Is there a chance we can agree on a specific dollar amount, if at all?

Then they started sending me messages - I was at work in our Peoria Office and did not see my personal phone until late in the afternoon. I had not heard anything.

I know, I talked to Stan after the request of NWGIC expenditures and was told all transactions were appropriate. If you recall, when I took over as Treasurer, since I work for the U.S. Treasury Department, I made sure we followed the IRS rules. We also followed the guidelines for paying people per the instructions - all money had to go through Sherri Cheli. All Checks were made out to Normal West HS - I have the copies from Heartland Bank if needed.

Then, this morning I receive a call saying Coach Hess was told, yesterday he has the choice of resigning or getting fired due to payments to assistant coaches. Much like banking laws and regulations - this most likely boils down to interpretation and application, but I do not have the information to know that for sure.

Like I have told the people contacting me - I do not have the information that was presented to Coach Hess, what the guidelines say or how they are being interpreted against how transactions were completed. I do not know. I do know, we have followed IRS regulations, which should suffice. Otherwise, I should hope it is not a matter of semantics and pettiness of

how payments are made - which happens with people who are outside of the financial industry.
