Incident Narrative

Reporting SERGEANT MATTHEW LANE - MCSP, ID # 9070 1 06/21/2016 09:14

On 06/21/16 at approximately 0840 I met with [REDACTED] in his office at McLean County Probation. [REDACTED] informed me that Probation Officer Jodi Cooper had been placed on administrative leave on 06/14/16. On 06/16/16 Officer Cooper called in to the probation department as directed at 0900 hrs. At the time of her call, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] asked if there was any cash or things of value in Cooper's desk that needed to be secured. Officer Cooper said that there was "drug court cash" that had recently been obtained from "Recovery Starts Today" in her desk drawer that needed to be secure. Officer Cooper described it as being in a white envelope. Officer Cooper was unsure if the white envelope has a window in it or not. The estimate of cash in the envelope was \$1342.00.

[REDACTED] looked in Officer Cooper's desk but could not find the cash. He did locate an unlocked lock box in the third drawer down on the left side of Officer Coopers desk but all that it contained was change and receipts. [REDACTED] did not know why the box was left unlocked or why the cash wasn't kept in it.

On 06/17/16 when Officer Cooper called in, [REDACTED] again asked her about the money and where it might be. Officer Cooper again stated that it should be in her desk drawer in a white envelope. When asked when the last time was that she had seen the envelope with the money in it Officer Cooper said approximately May 11, 2016. At one point Officer Cooper offered to have her mother loan her the money so that it could be replaced. Officer Cooper expressed that she felt that she was being set up. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then went to Officer Cooper's desk and searched it thoroughly. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] was able to find a white envelope with a window in it that appeared that it had something in it but the envelope was empty. None of the money was located. Later that same day they searched the desk again but still found nothing. [REDACTED] provided me with the white envelope. He stated that he and [REDACTED] had both handled the envelope.

[REDACTED] informed me that Officer Cooper's desk and office had been unlocked and that they normally stayed unlocked.

The envelope was placed into evidence.

This case is being forwarded to the Criminal Investigations Division for further investigation.
